### Project Details:

ER Stuebner was selected to construct a Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics (S.T.E.M.) Complex for Delaware County Community College. This project is a 4-story building situated on a wooded College Campus in Media, PA. The building was designed to integrate into the landscape; a portion of the second story overhangs an existing wetland conservation area. This project also incorporates a 3-story Aluminum and Glass “Prism” which can be viewed from all sides including the bottom, as it incorporates a glass floor. This intended to be the display area for the College as it welcomes all to the College campus. This building is LEED Certified Silver, and includes special details including a Vegetative Roof, which is intended to reduce the amount of water runoff from the roof.
